The internet is an 'interconnected network' of computers.

Always check with a grown-up if you want to try out a new website.

Remember, **anyone** can add things to the internet and not everything is suitable for children.

Grown-ups can help you to find a website that is fun and safe for children.



Sometimes, things can pop up on your screen and you don't know what they are.

Never click on things that don't look like they should be there!

Always tell a grown up if something pops up that you don't like the look of.

Always tell a grown up if something makes you feel scared or worried.



Never talk to people you don't know on the internet.

You wouldn't talk to a stranger if you met them in the real world. Never tell people on the Internet your name, where you live, or which school you go to.

Just like in the real world, the Internet has people who can be both kind and unkind using it.

If anyone tries to send you a message or chat to you you when you are using the Internet, you should always tell a grownup.



Stay Safe Online

So how can we use the Internet for all the fun things but still stay safe?

Always tell a grown-up when you are using the Internet and let them help you to choose safe websites.



Always tell a grown-up if something you are not expecting comes onto your screen. Always tell if you see or hear something that makes you feel scared or worried.

Always tell a grown-up if someone you don't know sends you a message or tries to speak to you on the Internet.
