Sun Cream, labelled with child's name



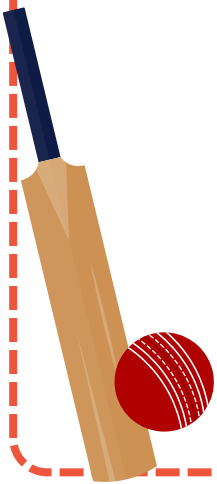

Well done to our super swimmers in Class 16. Harvin has achieved his 'I can swim' badge and Dolton has achieved his 5m & 10m badges.

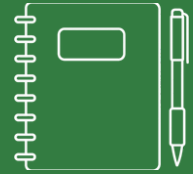
