Expressive Arts & Design—Exploring and using Media and Material - Music - Being Imaginative

A gift list has been put together to support your children at their developmental levels. There are lots of lovely gifts out there that your children will enjoy.

Step 1-3

Exploring and Using Media and Materials

- Resonance board—this is gives your child more feedback through vibrations which helps develop spatial and auditory awareness
- Sensory scarves—these can be used to move over your child's body, through their hands developing a sense of body awareness as well as being bright they can be used to encourage your child to look at the different colours





Music

 Instruments—instruments can be used to support alertness and awareness of sound.
These can also be used on the resonance board to feeling the vibrations.



<u>Step 4-5</u>

Exploring and Using Media and Materials

Variety of paint brushes—these have a variety of different textures that can be used with or without paint. Handles are a good size for children learning to grasp tools.

Music

- A variety of percussion instruments— familiar sounds through music and instruments. Encouraging children to hold, shake, tap, bang, turn instruments.
- Bluetooth light up speaker—lights move to music and vibrations can be felt on the resonance board





<u>Step 6-7</u>

Exploring and Using Media and Materials

 Tuff trays are great for putting lots of different materials in, it keeps the materials contained while allowing your child to explore with their whole body



 Play dough or similar materials —encourages pulling, poking, prodding, squeezing, pinching, splatting, smearing.



Music

 Keyboard & percussion instruments—children will enjoys recognising they are making their own sounds and will repeat their actions





Step 8-9

Exploring and Using Media and Materials

 Variety of bright coloured paper materials—children can choose what materials and colours they prefer.



Treasure baskets—metal, natural, shiny, noisy,





Music

Drum kit / Key board / micro phone—preferred musical instrument





Step 10-11

Exploring and Using Media and Materials

 Easels and doodle mats provide a great opportunity for children to be creative on a range of different surfaces












Use lots of old packaging to create junk models

Music

- Nursery Rhyme books with CD's so children can listen and sing along to their favourite nursery rhymes,
- Microphone/ Karaoke machine
- Sensory lights that move in time with music





Step 12-13

Exploring and Using Media and Materials

- Use materials to create a person—pompom for head, lolly pop stick for body etc.
- Laminating sheets or food bags with paint inside—children can mark make on to them, mix paint and see the effects
- A variety of paints, colours, tools to mix colours and notice the changes.—paint brushes, rollers, sticks, sponges etc.

A wide variety of tools—scissors, glue, glues spreaders, rollers, sponges, chalks, felts, crayons,


