

HELPFUL HOME LEARNING HINTS FOR TEACHING CHILDREN WITH A HEARING IMPAIRMENT



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Here are some simple and useful ways in which you can help your child to learn to the best of their ability whilst working at home. These tips include things that you can easily manage in the home environment to create the best space for your child to learn. - 1) Ensure that your child is wearing their hearing aids before starting an activity.
- 2) Provide a distraction-free environment by turning off the television, radio or any appliances that make a noise around the home. Also remove any toys from the area in which your child is working if they are distracted by them.
- 3) Have a clear place to work that is appropriate for your child's needs e.g. at a table or seated on the floor.
- 4) If participating in a live learning session via Teams, mute the microphones of all the other participants so that just the session leader can be heard by your child.
