### **Bonfire Night**

- Sparklers should not be given to children under five.
- Sparklers should not be waved close to other people.
- Anyone holding a sparkler should keep it at an arm's length and wear gloves.
- After they have been used, sparklers should be placed in a bucket of cold water.
