Steps 4 and 5

Help me by:

- Offer me instruments (e.g. bells, rattles, musical toys) or tools (e.g. sponges/brushes) to use during creative play together.
- Offer me lots of materials (different textures, weights, colours) for me to engage with.
- Try repeating one syllable, such as "ba", "ma", "ga", to me over and over. I may even add another syllable or two, making my sounds more complex.
- Ensure that music is a big part of my environment.
- Try putting something brightly-coloured, like a rattle, into my hands – I may hold it for a few seconds. If you try the with a crinkly toy, see what I do when it makes a noise
- Wrist rattles will help me develop more hand-eye co-ordination and muscle control as I work out how to operate it.
