(2-6 months)

Tactile stimuli

Share a variety of sensory stories with me. Let me explore a range of objects/materials from the story.

Allow me to explore different materials such as soft, hard, rough, smooth materials. Do I show an interest by reaching out to explore the different sensory elements.

Vibrating stimuli

Share a variety of interaction songs with me using instruments that vibrate such as ocean drums, pull string toys and the resonance board.

Allow me to feel the vibrations with my hands.

Row row your boat



Movement

Sit with your child and do a wide range of on body interaction rhymes such as row row row your boat. Hold your child so they can feel their body moving in different directions. Does your child anticipate a movement to a repetitive song/ rhyme.

Book Skills

Share a story with your child , encourage them to look at the book. Let your child explore some musical, touchy feely books. Do they show an interest by looking or reaching towards the book.
